Bible Study 101 (part 2)

In our next read through whatever book we have chosen I want us to look for the author's theme. When we take the time to read through the book as a whole, we will usually find out the general theme of the book. For me the theme of Philippians is gratitude and love. This is what I get out of reading the book as a whole. Again, this is not to take away from reading particular verses and understanding them but a general theme. This also helps to understand the context of the verses within the book.

I then want us to read the book looking for keywords, words that stand out as important. These words help us to understand the theme and the message of the writer. They identify key passages in the book. They are important to understanding the context of the book. Write these words down in your journal and take some time to look them up. Use a few translations of Scripture (for example, KJV, NASB, NIV, ESV) to see if they all use the same word and if they don't why not? I don't want to send you on too far a quest but a good English to Greek interlinear is a great tool. Sometimes I find it helpful to look up the Greek word in a Greek lexicon to see the meaning(s).

So, why am I asking you to do these things? I am not just trying to waste your time, nor am I trying to get you to change your mind about Scripture. I hold Scripture to be the infallible word of the Loving God. I am asking you to consider these study techniques or habits as a way of possibly improving your study habits as they have mine. It is my prayer that you find these, or some of these, helpful to you.

My overall goal with these articles is to highlight the importance of Bible study in our lives. Paul tell Timothy in 2 Timothy 2:15, "Do your best to present yourself to God as on approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth." (NIV) The NASB starts this verse off with; "Be diligent" while the KJV states "Study." If you consider each starting phrase, you may just get different ideas in your mind about what Paul is saying. Looking at them together in the different versions helps in understanding the verse. We need to send time studying God's word and making it a part of our lives so we can know how to handle the difficulties that arise in our lives as God would have us handle them.

Together let's study to show ourselves approved.
