A SUBMISSIVE HEART

Most of us know the story of Rahab in the book of Joshua. She is the one who hid the spies, sent by Joshua, from the enemy in Jericho. Rahab said some interesting things to the Israelite spies while they were on her roof. She said that she heard how the LORD had delivered the Israelites from Egypt and how He helped them defeat their enemies. She said, "I know that the LORD has given this land to you... we have heard how the Lord dried up the water of the Red Sea for you when you came out of Egypt... and what you did to Sihon and Og, the two kings of the Amorites east of the Jordan, whom you completely destroyed... the LORD your God is God in heaven above and on the earth below." (Joshua 2:9-11) Rahab and the people of Jericho were Gentiles, but yet they knew about God and what He had done for the people of Israel. God had said to Pharaoh through Moses, "I have raised you up for this very purpose, that I might show you my power and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth." Everyone in Jericho and the surrounding land knew about the God of Israel. What made Rahab stand out among them? For one, she was convinced by the evidence that the God of the Israelites was the actual "God in heaven above and on the earth below." Secondly, and most important, she had a heart that was willing to submit to God. She went to live with the Israelites and submit to their God. (Josh 6:25). Her submission to God was proven by her faith in the power of God. Hebrews 11:31 says, "By faith the prostitute, Rahab, because she welcomed the spies, was not killed with those who were disobedient."

It is not enough to simply understand the evidence, but one must have a heart that is willing to submit to that evidence. Jesus says in John 7:17, "If anyone chooses to do God's will, he will find out whether my teaching comes from God or whether I speak on my own." Rahab was willing to believe the evidence and she had a submissive heart as well. As Christians, let us have willing and submissive hearts, submitting to God's Word. Hebrews 11:6 says, "Without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him."
