On Thursday, I saw something someone posted on social media that was a clear statement of their disdain for God, Christianity, and the Lord's Church. Well, let's let Paul tell us in his own words from 1 Timothy 1:15-16, where he writes, "Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners-of whom I am the worst. But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his unlimited patience as an example for those who would believe on him and receive eternal life."

I don't dislike the ungodly message that was posted on social media any less, but after our lesson from God's Word, my heart was softened

for the person who posted it. It was the humbling lesson that I needed to hear that night, as a reminder to me that Jesus died for every single person on this earth. My resentment and hatred turned to compassion and love. Instead of going to bed tossing and turning, I went to bed with peace in my heart as I prayed for a person who needs Jesus just as much as I need Jesus. At the end of the day, I had a greater appreciation and love for my Lord Jesus Christ, who gave His life for me, a sinner. I am so thankful for our Men's Bible Study.
