A Plan Completed

Today most of Christendom will celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. We know that Scripture does not aside a single day of the year to do this but that we are supposed to celebrate Jesus' resurrection every day of our lives. Jesus is the fulfillment of God's plan to redeem mankind and bring us back into the relationship He intended for us to have with Him.

Colossians 1:15-23 states, "The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation—if you continue in your faith, established and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, have become a servant." So, not only is Jesus above everything, Paul states that Jesus is the firstborn from among the dead. Jesus is the first one to die and rise from the dead never to die again. There is no one else in Scripture that has risen from the dead never to die again. As Christians we have the hope to rise from the dead to spend eternity with Jesus in heaven. This is our daily hope in Christ! Not a once a year hope but a daily hope. Let's live every day with the excitement of Easter and the resurrection of a living Savior. Let us take that resurrection hope we have and share it with everyone we meet, that way they too can have the same hope we have.
