One of the most amazing images in the Bible is the concept that the church is Christ's Bride. In order to understand this image completely, we have to understand what a Jewish wedding was like in the first century. There was an initial engagement or what was called a betrothal. Often marriages were arranged by the family of a man and woman. After the betrothal took place, the couple was considered husband and wife, but they still remained apart. During the betrothal period both the groom and the bride to be were supposed to remain faithful to one another. The time leading up to the wedding was filled with anticipation and excitement as the couple prepared for their union. Then, at an unknown time the groom would return to claim his bride. At that time there would be a wedding feast and a formal uniting of the couple, and they would live together and begin their life as husband and wife.

This is much like the relationship the church shares with Christ. Jesus is the bridegroom and the church is His bride. This relationship is mentioned in Revelation 19:6-9 where John is given a vision from God. It a picture of the bridegroom coming to claim the one betrothed to Him (that would be us, the church of Christ). John writes, "Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude, like the roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting: 'Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear.' (Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of the saints.) Then the angel said to me, 'Write: Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!' And he added, 'These are the true words of God.'"

What is being talked about here in Revelation 19 is the most intimate of relationships. This is not a temporary relationship that God calls us to, but rather a lifetime of growing closer to Him. Christ has a love for us that led Him to stretch out His arms and allow nails to be driven through His wrists and feet. As He hung on that cruel cross, He could have called 10,000 angels and put a stop to it. But, if He did, the wedding would have been off. The wedding could not happen without His sacrifice. It surely would not happen because of anything His bride, the church could do. The bride is not worthy to wear the white garment of righteousness because of sin. Isaiah 64:6 says that "all our righteous acts are like filthy rags." If it depended on us, there would be no wedding. But Jesus longs to live out eternity with His betrothed. So with the blood He shed on the cross, He purchased a garment of righteousness worthy of a royal wedding. Isaiah 61:10 says, "For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels."

All that is left for us to do, as Jesus' bride, is to look our best for Him. Most brides before their wedding want to make sure everything is right, their dress, their hair; it all needs to be just right. Why? Not so their fiancé will marry them, but so they will look their best because their fiancée is marrying them. The same is true for us. We want to look our best for Christ. We want our hearts to be pure and our thoughts to be clean. We want our lives to be marked by grace and love. Jesus is spending this time in anticipation of the wedding day when He will come back and claim His bride. He is preparing the place that we will call home for eternity. (John 14:2-3) Now the question that every one of us must answer is, "What am I doing to prepare myself for His return?"
