In 2003, Dany Heatley could have gone to prison, but instead, he went to the 2006 Olympics as a part of the Canadian Olympic team. It was only made possible because of the forgiving heart of Dan Snyder's family.

In 2003, Dan Heatley and Dan Snyder were teammates and friends on the Atlanta Thrashers hockey team. One day in September, they got into Dan Heatley's Ferrari 360 for an early fall drive. Both were seriously injured when the car flew off the road and crashed into a wall, splitting the car in half and ejecting both of them from the vehicle. Heatley survived, but his friend, Snyder, did not. Heatley was charged with vehicular homicide because he was driving too fast for conditions, failed to maintain a lane, and speeding.

Dan Snyder's parents could have "thrown the book" at the man who killed their son. However something stopped them from doing that. It was something they believed in as a faithful Christian family.... Forgiveness! Graham Snyder (Dan's dad), could have asked the judge to go after Heatley on a charge of vehicular homicide, but did not. Instead, he asked the judge not to send Heatley to jail. Thejudge was touched by the hearts of the Snyder family and only sentenced Heatley to serve three years' probation.

Graham Snyder knew something important about forgiveness. It gives a person peace in their heart and allows them to go on with their life for God. Bitterness, anger, and resentment only stop life in its tracks and cause a lot more pain. Graham is quoted as saying, "Forgiveness helped my family move on. We are all human beings, and we know that humans make mistakes. We do not lay blame on Dany Heatley for the accident that took our son from us..."

When Peter asked Jesus how many times he should forgive someone, Jesus surprised Peter by telling him to forgive someone "seventy-seven times." (Matthew 18:22) Jesus' words suggest the idea of never-ending forgiveness. Forgiving others is one more way for us to look up to God and thank Him for the love that He showed us by sending His Son to die for our sins on the cross. (John 3:16) Ephesians 4:32 tells us, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Who do you need to forgive today?
