Making a Fresh Start in 2025

"Starting fresh", "a new slate", "a second chance", "a new beginning"... These are all phrases that we are used to hearing and even saying ourselves at the beginning of a new year. We can all start fresh, if we choose. In 2024, we may have fallen and want a fresh start, or we may have gone far and want to go further. However, we need to do so by taking our place in the "School of Christ" and be taught by Him. Ephesians 4:21 says we are "taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus."

Ephesians 4:22-24 tells us, "You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness." Our struggle is a daily struggle. In Luke 9:23, Jesus says, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me."

In order to renew our minds and keep our "new self" clean daily, we need the help of the Holy Spirit. He entered our hearts at the moment of our obedience to God (Acts 2:38) and has been with us ever since. Paul recognized the power of the Holy Spirit within each and every one of us when he addressed the church in Ephesus. In Ephesians 3:16, he said, "I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with the power through his Spirit in our inner being." Allow the Holy Spirit to work in your life, daily. If we allow Him to, He will give us a hunger for the things of God in 2025, such as: witnessing to others, obeying God, and Christian living.
