Does Satan live in your Neighborhood?

In Revelation 2:12-17, Jesus speaks to the church of Christ in the ancient city of Pergamum. Jesus said to the Christians there, "I know where you live – where Satan has his throne. Yet you remain true to my name. You did not renounce your faith in me, even in the days of Antipas, my faithful witness, who was put to death in your city – where Satan lives." (Rev. 2:13)

Imagine living in a place where Satan has his throne and where Satan lives? The people of Pergamum had built many temples and altars to many false gods, such as Athena and Zeus. There was also the temple dedicated to the snake god of healing, Aesculapius. People believed that simply sleeping in this temple would heal them of their diseases. And of course, there was the usual emperor worship that went on, where a Christian would be imprisoned or burnt at the stake, like Antipas, if they did not bow down to Caesar, as one would a god. Satan definitely was present in Pergamum. Is Satan present where we live? Well, the temple of the snake god may not be on the corner, but other influences of Satan are definitely present. Whether it is at the work place, in our children's schools, or even in our own homes, Satan has his ways of challenging our faith each and every day.

Jesus commended the Christians in Pergamum because they remained true to His name and did not renounce their faith in Him. The Christians chose not to escape, but to conquer. We may feel it would be much easier to be a Christian in some other place and in some other circumstances. The truth is, according to 1 Peter 5:8, Satan "prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour," no matter where we go or live. If in the early days Christians had run away every time they were confronted with a difficult engagement, there would have been no chance for Truth about Jesus to be made known.

The Christians at Pergamum proved that it was perfectly possible to be a Christian under such circumstances. Even when martyrdom was in the air they did not flinch. Jesus called Antipas "my faithful witness." The English word, "witness," is translated from the Greek word, "martus," or what we would call "martyr." In the early church to be a martyr and to be a witness were one and the same thing. Witnessing for Jesus often meant martyrdom. Here is a rebuke for us to consider. So many of us are prepared to demonstrate our Christianity in Christian circles, but are equally prepared to hide it in circles where Christianity is met with opposition.

Jesus give Antipas the name, "faithful witness." In Revelation 1:5, Jesus Himself is called the "faithful witness." To those who are true to Jesus, He gives nothing less than His own name. The testing of our faith by Satan today really is not much different than it was for the Christians of Pergamum then. If we remain faithful to Jesus, there is no reason why we, like Antipas, cannot be given His own name. Let's be faithful witnesses for Jesus!
