Is Influencing a Few Good Enough?

A man returning from a fishing trip was asked if he had caught any fish. "No," he replied, "but I influenced a few!" I think if someone actually said that to us, we would think that their fishing trip was not a successful one. If you go fishing and do not catch any fish, then whatever "influence" you made is meaningless. However, in terms of evangelism this makes perfect sense. In terms of evangelism, "influencing" as well as "catching" is a very important part of our responsibility in evangelism. Often we think that if our witnessing to someone does not end with their decision to respond to the Gospel, we have failed. But this thinking is mistaken for two reasons. First, thinking that unless there is a commitment to the Gospel we have failed, mistakes our role for God's role. God does not judge us on "outcomes." God judges us on faithfulness. God and only God can save. Only He can bring about a genuine decision to follow Christ. Our success in evangelism is judged in terms of faithfulness. Jesus said, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation." (MK. 16:15) God judges our success on whether or not we have been faithful to Him. 1 Corinthians 4:2 says, "It is required of stewards to be faithful." With evangelism, being faithful means sharing the good news. Our success is not measured by the outcome of our sharing the good news, only that we shared it.

Second, thinking that we have failed unless there is a decision to obey the Gospel, is judging prematurely. We do not know how our witnessing will serve to influence someone for Christ and lead to a later conversion. It might be that we will plant a seed that another will water and cultivate later on. This is an analogy the apostle Paul used when he said in 1 Corinthians 3:6, "I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow." This is how the gospel advanced in Corinth. Paul went in first with the gospel, and some were saved. Apollos came in later and picked up where Paul left off, and a lot more came to Christ. Paul planted, and Apollos watered. But it was neither Paul nor Apollos that actually caused the success. God is the one who made the church grow and worked on the hearts of those who obeyed the Gospel.

So, when you are fishing for people, you may not catch any, but while trying you may very well influence many! God may send you to someone simply as an initial contact. Through you God may first capture his or her attention. Then God may send another to continue the work where you left off. Then again God may use you as that second or third or 100th contact that actually results in someone's conversion. Do not be discouraged or think you are a failure because you do not see instant results. Be faithful, and in your faithfulness be assured of God's approval, and be encouraged in it. God saves! God gives the increase! God gives us the awesome privilege of being a part of the process. At the end of next week you might be able to say you "caught" a few. Or you might be able to say you have "influenced" a few. Faithfulness in any part of this process is success in the eyes of God.
