Seeing lightning bugs put on their show always brings a wave of nostalgia. Remembering as a kid chasing and catching them ,putting them in a mason jar with holes punched into the top and grass inside the jar.

The lightning bug, firefly or their official name Lampyridae use their light to communicate.

As I watched their magical show I I thought of the Bible's instructions to "let your light shine".

## The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. (John 1:5)

Darkness cannot stop the light. Even the small light on the underside of a beetle dispels the darkest night. Wherever the beetle shines its light, the dark is illuminated with a glow.
