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4 Expressions of the Cross

What is MOST important to you??? Paul said in 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, "For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures." The death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ should be our central message. Not only a message to live by, but also one to pass on to others. Why? I would like to suggest four reasons in this article. Four expressions of the cross.

One, the cross of Christ points to mankind's sinful state. The cross is a reminder that "I am a sinner and that I am lost." Jesus took the punishment I deserve for my sin, upon Himself, on the cross. And for that, I am thankful.

Two, the cross expresses the great love of God for mankind. God's love for us is so strong, He gave us everything so we may be saved. He gave us His one and only Son. The sacrifice Jesus made for us is an example of God's perfect love for us.

Three, the cross is the only means of salvation. The world says there are many ways to heaven. The Bible says there is only one way to heaven; the cross of Christ. The world will tell you to find hope and peace and joy in worldly possessions and worldly success and worldly relationships. However, true hope and peace and joy only is found in Jesus Christ because what Jesus offers is eternal; eternal life.

Four, there is the challenge of the cross. The challenge of the cross is twofold. First, there is the challenge to believe in it and obey it. That is, to die to sin and be raised to a new life in the waters of baptism as commanded by our Lord. In Mark 16:16, Jesus said, "believe and be baptized and you will be saved." Second, there is the challenge to take up our cross daily. That is, to make our lives a living sacrifice for the Lord. Essentially, giving all of self for Him. Are you up for the challenge?
