## THE BIG GAME.... OF LIFE

The NFL season is only 17 games long. That does not sound like a lot of games. However, for the men who play the game, it is a weekly physical battle, filled with injuries, blood, sweat, bumps, bruises, and a vast range of emotions. There are 32 teams that play this grueling season in hopes to make it to the Super Bowl, but only one team will be crowned Super Bowl Champion. At the end of the NFL football season, only one team will be holding up the victory prize, called the Vince Lombardi Trophy (named after the coach who won the first two Super Bowls).

The Bible relates very much to mankind's fascination with sports and effort that goes into winning. In fact, Paul addresses Christians in 1 Corinthians 9:24 saying, "Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize." The prize Paul is talking about is not the Vince Lombardi Trophy, but rather something far greater. Paul is talking about the prize of eternal life found only in Christ Jesus our Lord. It is a prize for anyone who will choose to believe in Jesus as the Lord and Savior, repent of their sins, be immersed in water in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins, and then live a life faithful to Him. Paul's intention in verse 24 is not to affirm that only one individual will receive the prize of eternal life. Rather, Paul challenges his readers to participate in the race in a way that will ensure that they will receive the prize. How does one insure this?

This year's Super Bowl teams (Patriots & Seahawks) have been training hard all season to get to this point. They have worked out in the weight rooms, run miles and miles, practiced with their team, and followed nutritional diets. As Christians, we need to train hard too if we want to get the prize of eternal life. Paul goes on to say in verse 25-29, "Everyone who competes in the games goes into strict training. They do it to get a crown that will not last; but we do it to get a crown that will last forever. Therefore, I do not run like a man running aimlessly; I do not fight like a man beating the air. No, I beat my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize." Paul says we insure ourselves the prize of eternal life by making our lives living sacrifices to Jesus.

Paul strived to make sure that he practiced self-control in his living, obeyed the teachings of Jesus, and was committed to doing the will of his Father in Heaven. In his letter to the Galatians, Paul said in chapter 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loves me and gave Himself for me." The game of football is tough, but the game of life is tougher. If we want to prize that God offers us, it will require more training, dedication, and sacrifice than any man-made game. Our play book is the Word of God; our example is the life of Jesus Christ. Our game plan is to obey His Word and follow His example. If we are faithful to the game plan, only then will we receive the prize of eternity with God forever in Heaven.
