MAY WE NEVER FORGET

Last Monday, our nation paused to observe Memorial Day—a time to remember the men and women who gave their lives in service to our country. Their sacrifice reminds us that freedom is never free. Countless families have carried the burden of loss so others could enjoy peace, liberty, and security. As Christians, when we think of sacrifice that brings freedom, we cannot help but reflect on the greatest sacrifice ever made: the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. While soldiers have died to preserve earthly freedom, Jesus died to provide eternal freedom from sin and death. Jesus said in John 15:13, “Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.” Those words certainly honor the courage of fallen heroes, but they also point directly to the cross, where Christ willingly laid down His life for us. The Apostle Paul wrote in Romans 5:8, “But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” What amazing grace that Jesus gave His life not because we deserved it, but because He loved us. Memorial Day is ultimately about remembrance. In Scripture, God repeatedly calls His people to remember; remember His works, remember His faithfulness, and remember His salvation. Psalm 77:11 says, “I will remember the deeds of the Lord; yes, I will remember your wonders of old.” As we honor the memory of those who served our nation, may we also remember the Savior who gave everything to save our souls. And may our gratitude for what He sacrificed for us, compel us to make our bodies living sacrifices to God. (Romans 12:1) Paul says in Galatians 2:20, “The life I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.” May our gratitude move us to live faithfully for the One who died and rose again. May we never forget.
